

Setting Up Your Avid Account


First things first, you need to set up and validate your Avid Account

Will Your Computer Run the Software?

Before installing the software, use the links below to check that your computer is capable of running the software. Generally speaking, you need a fast computer with a minimum of 16GB of RAM.

Even if your computer does not meet minimum system requirements may still be able to run the software, Avid simply cannot guarantee functionality.

Accessing Older Versions of Software

The temporary license you receive will run the latest version of Avid software, as well as older versions, including:

- Media Composer 2018.9 and above
 - o 2018.x is the classic interface
 - o 2019.x and 2020.x have the new interface
- Pro Tools v.12 and above
- Sibelius v.7 and above

Activating Your eBook

Avid is offering temporary ebooks for those students who do not have access to the books they purchased for class. Let your instructor know if you need one.


When you purchase an Avid ebook, it is yours to keep. You can open it on multiple devices, and create and save study notes. Temporary ebooks are for use on one device only. Whichever device you use to activate the ebook will be the only device on which you can use it. We also recommend taking notes in another app or on a different device. Any notes made in a temporary ebook will be lost when the ebook expires.

If you requested a temporary ebook, you will receive the activation link at the same time that the software licenses are distributed.

To activate the ebook:

- 1. Open the email on the device you want to use to read your ebook.
- 2. Click the link in the email.

3. Follow the simple 3-step instructions on the page:

Your instructor may also request download links for each Avid certification course you are enrolled in. These links will give you the media and course files required to complete the lessons and exercises in the book.

Download links will be sent to you by email.
